DIRECTIONS TO THE AACA MUSEUM IN HERSHEY, PA.

The Museum is also known as the Antique Auto Museum– Hershey

FROM THE EAST:

- Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike East toward Harrisburg.
- Take the PA-72 exit, Exit 266, Lebanon-Lancaster.
- Turn left onto Lebanon Road/PA-72. Continue to follow PA-72 North.
- Stay straight to go onto US-322W.
- Turn right onto Homestead Road.
- Turn left onto E. Chocolate Ave/US-422W.
- Turn right onto Park Ave./PA-743
- Turn left onto Hershey Park Drive.
- Turn right onto Hershey Road/PA-39.
- Turn left onto Museum Drive. The Museum is straight ahead; parking is on your left.

FROM THE NORTH (Northern PA; New York;, Northern NJ; New England):

- Take I-78 W.
- Merge onto I-81 S via Exit 1B on the left toward Harrisburg, PA.
- Take the PA-39 exit, Exit 77, toward Manada Hill/Hershey.
- Turn slight left to take the ramp toward PA-39 E/Manada Hill/Hershey
- Turn left onto Linglestown Road/PA-39E. Continue to follow PA-39E.
- Turn right onto Museum Drive. The Museum is straight ahead. Parking is to your left.

FROM THE WEST (Pittsburgh):

- Take I-76E/Pennsylvania Turnpike.
- Merge onto Harrisburg Pike/US-11N via Exit 226 toward I-81/Harrisburg
- Merge onto I-81 N toward Harrisburg
- Merge onto PA-39 E via Exit 77 toward Manada Hill/Hershey
- Turn right onto Museum Drive. The Museum is straight ahead. Parking is to your left.

FROM THE SOUTH (Baltimore; Washington; Richmond):

- Take I-83 north from I-695 (Baltimore Beltway) to the PA Turnpike
- Take the PA Turnpike east, following the same directions as those given for Pittsburgh and points west.
